He spots the camera.

MAN
Oh, Good Evening!

He steps into the light to reveal--

DICK VAN DYKE
Dick Van Dyke here, one of the
special few --

He starts padding his pants and jacket pockets.

DICK VAN DYKE (CONT'D)
-- with the key... to the magic...

Like a showman with nothing to show, his panic and embarrassment quickly escalates.

DICK VAN DYKE (CONT'D)
...Disney... VAULT! Uh--

As a last ditch effort, he lifts the DOORMAT to the vault with his wingtip shoe. No key.

DICK VAN DYKE (CONT'D)
(under his breath)
I could really use a little of Mary
Poppins' magic right now.

Approaching from off camera, we hear a metal JINGLE coupled with the tiny canine footfall of BULLSEYE, who enters frame, proudly holding the MAGICAL KEY in his mouth.

(to dog)
*Hey little buddy. Where did you
find this? You must have found this-*
(remembers the camera)
Ahem, right where I safely left it.
(then, giddy)
Get ready for something special.

The key opens the lock. The vault door squeaks open. The camera PUSHES IN to reveal an infinite WAREHOUSE OF ECLECTIC AND ICONIC DISNEY TREASURES.

We're treated to several CLOSE-UPS of iconic items from STAR WARS, FROZEN, THE PARKS, ETC. as Dick and Bullseye walk past them, towards a stack of TIN FILM CANISTERS. Dick grabs "**MARY POPPINS** (1967)" which is nestled between "**THE SWORD IN THE STONE** (1963)" and "**THE JUNGLE BOOK** (1967)".

DICK VAN DYKE (CONT'D)

Ah, here it is. Mary Poppins. The timeless family classic starring Julie Andrews as a magical nanny who reminds us how important it is to create fun memories with your family - *in the most delightful way.*

Bullseye hops up on a DIRECTOR'S CHAIR so he's at waist-level with Dick.

DICK VAN DYKE (CONT'D)

And that's what tonight is all about. Memories. Which is why we're here in the Disney Vault. You see, for the next two hours, while you're at home with your loved ones *creating* memories, I'll be *sharing* some of my memories from making the movie.

Dick looks down to Bullseye.

DICK VAN DYKE (CONT'D)

(to dog)

Maybe you can help me find some of those memories buried in all this cool stuff, huh?

Bullseye gives an enthusiastic BARK!

Good boy. And now, Walt Disney's Classic - MARY POPPINS.
